Discussion

Galatians 6:6-10 has been one of my favorite passages for many years. There have been times in my life when doubt creeps in and gets me discouraged with the current circumstances. Sometimes the toil and work we do for the Kingdom of God seems to be useless and will not produce any good. I am always reminded that nothing we do is in vain but in due time a harvest is waiting for us, just like with this testimony.

Have you ever heard of Karl Friedrich Gützlaff? He was the first Lutheran missionary to China, and he was 48 years old when he died in 1851 in Hong Kong. Near the end of his life, he was disappointed as he did not see the results of his hard labor. However, the ministry he formed later sent out a missionary named J. Hudson Taylor, who opened the interior of China to the Gospel. Furthermore, Gützlaff's writings touched a British doctor named David Livingstone. Livingstone opened the interior of Africa to the Gospel. Gützlaff died with a sense of failure, yet his work ultimately resulted in the Gospel being spread into China and Africa.

When you donate to ministries, don't get discouraged if you do not see tangible results. Just remember God's promise if we sow bountifully, we will reap bountifully. Discouragement does not come from our Heavenly Father. We must continue to walk in faith, continue to do our work without losing heart, and allow God to let His plan unfold.
